Update on various projects

Triangle (Jubilee) Wood - a contractor is agreed with MBC. who will supervise the making safe of the wood. I'm told that Planning is happy with the proposed work, as is Richard Ward of course, but there is a slight technical issue re Forestry Commission regulations which should be sorted soon. The funds that are available will only cover this initial work (we've had other minor running costs too) so a grant from NPC will enable us to have the funds for tools and some materials to get our volunteers going!

Wildflowers - whilst there was some re-planting, as I was warned, the display is not quite so good this second year. I hope we can get this sorted next year.

Flower tubs. Chris Foggin of NCC, has worked very hard, along with a number of volunteer and Nunthorpe in Bloom to freshen displays. Chris and I have discussed this in detail and we believe a full rationalisation of tubs is required, so we have tubs that can be properly 'supported' by the volunteers and funding we have , and may have in the future. Some displays eg the Avenue and shops , have been very well supported by shopkeepers who watered displays described by one resident as the Hanging Gardens of Babylon!
